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VISITORS SURVEY 2007

Summary of Results

1. This report presents the results of four surveys on departing visitors which were carried out at the airport between the following dates:

26th March - 1st April 2007

25th Jun - 1st July 2007

24th - 30th September 2007

3rd – 9th December 2007

2. For each flight departing during the survey periods, questionnaires were given to nearly all families entering the departure lounge. Departing residents and people transiting for less than one night were excluded.
3. These surveys are the only source of information which combines the length of stay of visitors with their countries or regions of residence. Details of expenditure in Seychelles are requested from the visitors and overall expenditure estimates are derived by using these figures in conjunction with information collected from tourism accommodation establishments.
4. Other indicators that are collected include details on multi-destination holidays, return visits, level of enjoyment, involvement of tour operators, place of stay and islands visited.
5. As a special appendix to the report, certain tables are presented in their historical context, as these surveys have been carried out at four monthly intervals since April 1981 and so provide a useful time-series of data.
6. Details of country of residence and length of stay are given in Tables 1 and 2. Visitors from Germany recorded the longest average length of stay (12.7), followed by Switzerland (11.2), UK & Eire (10.3), Other Europe (10.0), Italy (9.9), France (9.7), Africa (8.5), and Elsewhere (6.6) nights. The overall average length of stay (excluding persons staying for less than one night) was 10.0 nights compared to 10.0 nights from embarkation cards.
7. The distribution of length of stay varies according to country of residence (Tables 1 and 3). Noticeably, visitors from Germany, Switzerland, UK & Eire and Other Europe are staying for longer periods.
8. Expenditure in Seychelles per visitor night was R497 if locally paid hotel bills are included and R404 if excluded (Tables 4, 5 and 6). The figure R497 represents an increase of 31.8% on the figure for 2006.
9. Table 7 presents the total income from tourists in the years 2003 to 2007. Income has been estimated as Rm1595 in 2007 compared to Rm994 in 2006.

10. Eighty-four percent (84%) of visitors, visited Seychelles only compared to 85% in 2006. Sixty-six percent (66%) of visitors came via a tour operator and 18% were repeat visitors. The level of enjoyment decreased from 85% in 2006 to 84% in 2007 and the overall pattern of accommodation decreased slightly (Tables 8 - 12)
11. In the tables, United Kingdom includes Eire and the C.I.S is included in Other Europe.
12. In all tables where an overall average or percentage has been calculated, a weighted figure has been published. These weights have been obtained based on the actual arrivals (or departures) for each region in the months surrounding the survey. This is necessary, since the number of visitors from each region who were covered by the surveys are in different proportions to those actually recorded by immigration.

Country of Residence and Length of Stay

13. Table 1 summarises the distribution of length of stay for the different countries and region, and compares the information collected from the surveys with that collected from the disembarkation cards. As in previous years, tourists from some countries maybe over-represented in the sample.
14. Table 2 presents the average length of stay by country of residence. The average length of stay for 2007 decreased compared to 2006.
15. Table 3 presents the breakdown by country and length of stay for the sample of visitors surveyed. One and two week holidays remain popular.

Expenditure in Seychelles

16. In Table 4, the difference in expenditure patterns between the four survey periods are given. The "Hotel Bill" figure refers to money paid for board in Seychelles, rather than payment in advance and it is subtracted from the total figure because when it does happen that a tourist pays for all his accommodation locally, the figures are so high that the overall picture is distorted. The "Other hotel" figure refers to the money spent on drinks, extra meals in the hotel, room-service, etc; a sum which is spent by most tourists.
17. Tables 5 and 6 give the expenditure information collected in the surveys. The analyses are based on 4575 persons, and as mentioned above, the "Overall" figures are a weighted average of the regional figures. The list of items covered has been increased slightly by the new questionnaire.
18. Differences in patterns of expenditure between the principal regions and countries of residence are highlighted in Table 5, while Table 6 presents the same data as percentages for easier reference.

19. From previous analysis, the correlation between length of stay and expenditure per night excluding hotel bills is known. The figure for 14 - 15 night holidays is higher than average, because this is the length of stay corresponding to the majority of the package tours. Tourists who either stay for periods of a week or less, or who arrange their own holidays, are likely to pay more.

Overall Estimates of Tourism Expenditure

20. Overall estimates of tourism expenditure for the years 2003 - 2007 are presented in Table 7. These are based on information provided by hotels and guest-houses in addition to expenditure information obtained from the airport surveys. Estimates are also made for pre-payments for car hire and excursions and for the expenditure of cruise ship and transit passengers who stay for less than one night.
21. Comparing 2007 with 2006, expenditure per visitor night excluding hotel bills (accommodation only) increased by 34%, (Tables 4 & 5).
22. Table 7 presents tourism expenditure estimate for the years 2003 - 2007. In 2007, the estimate (Rm1595) was 33.6% higher than that reported by the Central Bank (Rm1194). Using the Central Bank figure, income per visitor night stood at R748 in 2007 reflecting an increase of 16.5% over 2006 (R642).
23. Comparing the total expenditure estimate arrived at from the survey results with those reported by the Central Bank, the two sources reveal some variations, with the estimated expenditure higher than the Central Bank figures. In spite of these variations, both sets of figures are valuable indicators of income from tourism and their divergence gives an indication of the extent of the operations of the black/parallel market.

Other Indicators

24. Table 8 shows how visitors to Seychelles structure their holidays. An increasing percentage are visiting Seychelles only (Table 9), but of those who do visit other countries, it is noticeable how the nationalities differ in their choice.
25. Table 10 indicates that the percentage of those coming with an organised tour are more or less the same. In 2007, satisfaction with the holiday shows a decrease below that of 2006. 91% of the tourists who visited Seychelles, would recommend a Seychelles holiday to their friends.
26. Table 12 shows the place of stay and islands visited. The percentage of people staying in hotels and guest-houses together remain the same as in 2006. The visitors were asked about which islands they had visited. Seventy-eight percent (78%) visited Mahe and of those who visited other islands, about 72% went to Praslin and 63% to La Digue, with visitors from France, Germany and Italy being the most mobile.

Appendix - Comparative Tables

27. These tables present data for a continuous series of 84 surveys conducted every 3 months from April 1981 to December 2007. The data is presented as a time series in an attempt to highlight changes over that period.
28. Table A compares the average length of stay of visitors coming to Seychelles by country of residence for both the main markets and other areas. The figures show considerable regional differences and it is hard to spot a trend.
29. Table B presents expenditure per visitor-night in absolute values for the 12 surveys conducted from 2005 to 2007.
30. Table C takes into account changes in the overall level of prices. In order to compare actual and real expenditure, the actual expenditure data have been deflated by the index of imported and locally produced other food (excluding fish) and non-food items.
